

English

This half term we are studying the texts, Goldilocks and the Three Bears by Lauren Child, Cave Baby by Julia Donaldson and Stanley's Stick by John Hegley. Through these texts, we will be learning how to effectively write for a range of audience and purpose.

Science

Living things and their Habitats - Children will learn that ecology is the scientific study of the environment and that ecologists study ecosystems. Children will explore various ecosystems and the living things that live and survive within their non-living surroundings.

RE

Special Places - Explore what makes a place special. Develop understanding of Christians and their belief in God and learning why church is a special place to them. Children will then compare church to another place of worship.

Phonics

Children have 20 minutes of phonics everyday followed by a 20 minute guided reading session where they apply their new phonetic knowledge directly to a Read, Write, Inc. text.

PSHE

Being Me in My World - Learn how to make others feel welcome and to belong to a school community. This is explored through creation of a class agreed charter.

Music

I Wanna Play in a Band - Learning to sing, improvise and compose. (Adapted to follow COVID regulations)

P.E

Ball Skills - To master basic sending and receiving techniques and to develop balance, agility and coordination.

Computing

Grouping and Sorting - To sort items using a range of criteria. Lego Builders - To follow and create simple instructions. Maze Explorers - To use directional keys.

Maths

Children will explore numbers to 10 by counting using one - to-one correspondence and using ten frames to represent numbers. They will then be writing using both numerals and words. Children will explore the building blocks of numbers by exploring different ways of making numbers using the number bond diagrams. They will then explore adding to 10 and begin to use the part-whole model, laying the foundations for the inverse of addition.

History

The History of Me - To know that history is the study of past and future events. Explore words such as *past*, *future*, *chronology* and other words we use to describe the passing of time.

Toys, Now and Then - Explore how toys have changed over time and how and why things may change over time.

Art and Design

Digital Media - Explore photography through the study of a local female photographer, Hayley Blackledge.
