

English

This half term we are studying the texts, Cinderella of the Nile by Beverley Naidoo, Sparky by Jenny Offill and Winter's Child by Angela McAllister & Grahame Baker Smith. Through these texts the children will be given the opportunities to write for a range of audience and purpose.

Reading

Applying all reading skills to a range of contexts including, fiction, non-fiction, poetry and media.

Science

Raw and Synthetic Materials - Children will learn that a material is any substance that has a name and that a raw material is found in nature and has not been changed by humans and a synthetic material is made by humans.

R.E

Responsibility - Consider what it means to be responsible and consider people who show responsibility. Understand the importance of rules and how and why Moses received the Ten Commandments.

PSHE

Healthy Me - children will explore the importance of exercise and healthy lifestyle choices. They will study healthy food swaps and food labelling and how this can contribute to healthy choices. They will also explore attitudes towards drugs.

Music

Christmas - children will explore a range of Christmas songs and learn the story behind them and why it is tradition to sing songs at Christmas time.

P.E

Bollywood Dance - identify and practise the patterns and actions of Bollywood dancing.

Mighty Movers (running) - to explore running at different speeds and to use arms to aid speed.

Computing

Coding - Children will learn to use selection in coding with the 'if/else' command and to understand and use variables in 2Code. They will use flowcharts for design of algorithms including selection and use the 'repeat until' with variables to determine the repeat.

Maths

Children will learn to multiply by 3 by using relational properties. They will learn to multiply by 4 and 8 and to use the commutative law to multiply. Children will then learn to divide by 3, 4 and 8. They will then apply this knowledge and skill to problem solving type questions.

History

The Shang Dynasty - Children will learn how we know about the Shang Dynasty and when the era started. They will explore what life was like during this period of time and what the Shang people believed in. They will learn the role that Fu Hao played in the Shang Dynasty and how the Dynasty ended.

French

Little Red Riding Hood - 'Petit Chaperon Rouge' - learn key words and phrases of the traditional tale in French.

Design and Technology

Shell Structures - children will research and analyse a range of torches before designing, creating and evaluating their own torches.
