

English

This half term we are studying the texts, King Kong by Anthony Browne and Night Mail by W. H Auden. Through these texts the children will be given the opportunities to develop their writing skills and write for a range of audience and purpose.

Reading

Applying all reading skills to a range of contexts including, fiction, non-fiction, poetry and media.

Science

Physical and Chemical Change - children will study what happens during a state change and what chemical and physical changes are how to identify them. Children will then compare and investigate both changes in state.

R.E

Beliefs - children will learn that different religions have different beliefs and they worship different Gods. They will also learn that humanists have non-religious beliefs.

PSHE

Healthy Me - children will explore the effects of smoking and alcohol, including vapes. They will also discuss relationships with food and healthy lifestyle choices and the effects of body image.

Music

Christmas - children will explore a range of Christmas songs and learn the story behind them and why it is tradition to sing songs at Christmas time.

P.E

Dynamic Dance - to identify and practise the patterns and actions of the Bollywood dance style.

Mighty Movers - to perform a boxercise routine demonstrating good form and technique.

Computing

Coding - children will use the program design process, including flowcharts, to develop algorithms for more complex programs using and understanding of abstraction and decomposition to define the important aspects of the program.

Maths

Children will learn to read and write decimals to thousandths and to divide whole numbers by larger whole numbers. They will learn to divide whole numbers by larger whole numbers. Children will then convert common measurements into metres, centimetres and millimetres using knowledge of decimals and fractions to help convert units.

History

Medieval Monarchs - children will study the events leading up to and during the Battle of Hastings, including the different claims to the throne. They will explore who was responsible for the death of Thomas Beckett, who was the worst king: Richard or John and in what way was Edward I both 'a great and terrible' king.

French

Every day French - Continue to study common greetings, numbers, colours and days of the week.

Design and Technology

Frame Structures - children will research and analyse a range of pavilions before designing, creating and evaluating their own pavilion.
