

English

This half term we are studying the texts, Robot Girl by Malorie Blackman and The Templeton Twins by Ellie Weiner. Through these texts the children will be given the opportunities to develop their writing skills and write for a range of audience and purpose.

Reading

Applying all reading skills to a range of contexts including, fiction, non-fiction, poetry and media.

Science

Magnetism - children will explore what non-contact forces and magnets are. They will learn how a compass works and how we can see a magnetic field. They will then study the uses of magnetic objects and how we can tell whether an object is magnetic or not.

R.E

Islam - children will learn that Muslims worship in a mosque, to their God Allah and that the Muslim holy book is the Qur'an.

PSHE

Relationships - children will explore self-recognition and self-worth and learn how to build their own self-esteem. They will explore safe online communities and how to reduce their screen time. They will also be taught the dangers of online grooming.

Music

Fresh Prince of Bel Air - children will explore this well-known song and have the opportunity to write and perform their own hip hop rap.

Computing

Concept Maps - children will understand the need for visual representation when generating and discussing complex ideas. They will understand and use the correct vocabulary when creating a concept map and create their own concept map.

Maths

Children will revisit measurement and convert units of time from minutes to hours and represent time using the 24-hour clock. They will then move on to solve complex word problems using bar models and other pictorial representations.
